

TEACHER THOUGHTS

"I am able to bring 25 students into the computer lab, and they are all able to learn at their own level: Sokikom makes the computer itself a teaching tool that allows me to meet students at their level."

"Schools like mine really struggle on state testing - it is a good year if we get 25% of students to pass AIMS in a given year. This year, in my class we had over 50% of students pass the AIMS. I think this was largely due to my use of technology in class. Some people are just so old school...but I think Sokikom shows that technology works."
